Visiting instructors wishing to instruct in their own aircraft, or one of our fleet, must first satisfy the No 1 on duty that they are able to do so safely

- They must have read the visitors hand book and local flying rules
- They must, in the company of a fully rated instructor, examine the landable and non landable areas of the airfield, and should understand where to land in the event of a launch failure to the North, and when it is not safe to land on the airfield.
- To instruct in club aircraft they must have produced a current medical, and either left a deposit or paid the waiver to cover the insurance excess in the event of a claim.
