Introduction

This price list is for the membership year 2025-26. Updates will be issued whenever necessary.

Members' Payment Terms

- Annual charges are payable in advance by existing full members on the 1st of April in each
 year.
- New full members joining the Club after 1st April in any year pay a proportion of the same charges on joining calculated monthly. If you join the club after the 15th of the month, the remaining part of the month is not charged for.
- Full members pay all other charges (bar, caravan electric, launches and purchases from the club shop etc.) within the first 14 days of the month following the month in which the charges were incurred, or payment requested.
- If an associate junior member attains the age of 18 years during the membership year, they should apply to become a full member, but no further charges are payable until the following membership year.
- We will send out statements regularly. Members are encouraged to check their accounts so that prompt payment of any debit balance can be made.
- The Club reserves the right to suspend the flying privileges of any member who fails to pay any debit balance on their account within the 14 days period mentioned above provided that not less than 7 days' notice has first been given.
- Associate Course and Visitor members should pay all outstanding charges on the final day before departure.

Membership & Direct Debits

- Full Members may pay the annual charges in twelve equal instalments by direct debit.
- The direct debit is set up so that each instalment is paid within the first 7 days of each month beginning in April.
- Membership continues from year to year until cancelled. Cancellation of a direct debit mandate part way through a year will not cancel the balance of the outstanding annual charges payable for the year, which will remain due for payment forthwith.

Accounts

Members can have the following accounts: -

- **Flying and ancillary's account.** This is the account used for flying fees, bar and other purchases. If you are an associate member this also your membership account.
- **Subscription account.** If you are a full member, the subscription account is used for membership and caravan fees. This allows full members to spread the cost of membership over the year by direct debit. This account has the same number as your flying account but with a suffix "S".
- **Glider account**. This is a separate account for the glider trailer hitch and associated charges. The account number is the same as the trailer hitch number.

How to Pay




You can pay in the following ways: -

- Air League / Launch Point Trust. If you are fortunate enough to be in receipt of a bursary you must provide the office with details. Both schemes have an amount and period for which the voucher is valid. When the voucher has expired or your fees are more than the voucher's value, you are responsible for the outstanding amount.
- Bank Transfer. You can pay the Club using Bank Transfer. When doing so it is vital to quote your account number as the first part of the reference, followed by a dash before any additional text you choose to add, for example "0000 Espin Hardwick Launches". The account number is the same as your membership number. If you are paying your Membership fees, add a suffix of "S" to the account number. Please do not combine payments from different accounts as it makes allocation complex and may result in errors. The Club's bank account details are:


You can also pay in the following ways:

¹¹ Associate 2nd BGA Club. The primary club is where the pilot does the majority of their flying, and they are responsible for paying the BGA fees (capitation & instructor). The primary club must be declared on the application form. Evidence may be asked for to prove eligibility for second club status.

¹² Honorary Life membership is an associate membership class. If such a member wishes to fly, they will have to pay the annual BGA affiliation fee (£37 annually of £6 per day).

¹³ Introductory Membership is for 12 months from the of the first flight date.

¹⁴ To qualify for Introductory Membership, the member must not have gone solo or been a member of the Club or another BGA Club for ten years.

¹⁵ Associate Introductory Membership has an associated "activity packaged" that defines what is included in the membership, the activity package will charge from time to time.

¹⁶ Reciprocal membership applied to (1.) members of the "Rock Polisher's League" clubs during competitions and (2) members of Hereford Gliding Club and is limited to four visits per annum.

General Notes:

- The membership year runs from the 1st of April to the 31st of March in the following year. Membership for both full members and annual associate members continues until cancelled.
- Full members are entitled to a share and a vote and to stand for office and the Committee. Associate members do not have these privileges.
- Full membership subscriptions may be paid annually or monthly.
- Associate membership subscriptions are payable as a single amount.
- If a full member or an annual associate member wishes to resign from the Club at any time, notice in writing to this effect should be sent to the Secretary before the end of the membership year.
- If a member fails to pay their membership subscription and has been deemed to have resigned (see paragraph 8.2.2 of the Club's Statutory Rules) in any membership year and applies to re-join in that year, the whole of the annual subscription for the same year is payable.
- Where two or more people join from the same family as full members and living at the same address, a 25% discount is applied to the full membership subscriptions. This replaces the spouse discount.
- If you join during January, February or March, pay the current annual fee in full, and your membership runs to the end of March the following year.

²⁰ The Motor Glider is charged based on a nominal composite charge of £95.00 per hour. This is made up of two elements; (1) Flight time (airframe hours); and (2) Engine time (tacho hours). Flight time and engine hours are charged at £35.00 and £60.00 per hour, respectively.

²¹ The Introductory Membership sold before October 2020 does not include flying time in the motor glider. Introductory membership sold after includes up to one hour.

- Members can have exclusive use of the Junior or K8 for the day. The K23 is excluded. If the booking is cancelled before 10:00 no charge will be made.
- Members can reserve a club single seater for badge flights subject to a minimum charge of two hours. If the reservation is cancelled before 10:00 no charge will be made.
- Only one of the single seat gliders can be reserved or booked on any day.
- Pre-declared and authorised "BGA badge duration flights" are capped at two and a half hours 145 minutes charge time. Authorisation is by a note from the instructor in charge in the "remarks" column of the daily log sheet or the comments column of the electronic launch point logging systems.
- It is the pilot's responsibility to ensure the flight log is correct on the day.
